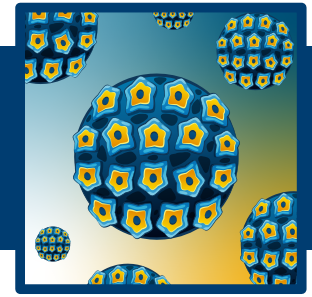

## Final Pitch Preparations

Keep in mind you are presenting to a School Board. Introduce yourself: state your grade-level and the school you attend. Speak clearly and don’t rush! When presenting your evidence, share the source of your evidence. Statements such as: “According to a recent peer-reviewed article...” or “A medical researcher stated...”. Keep in mind, you cannot exceed 3 minutes and anything you share will become part of the public record!

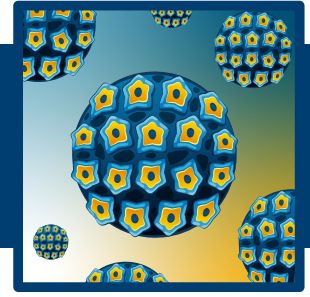
